Personal information is stolen and used without your knowledge

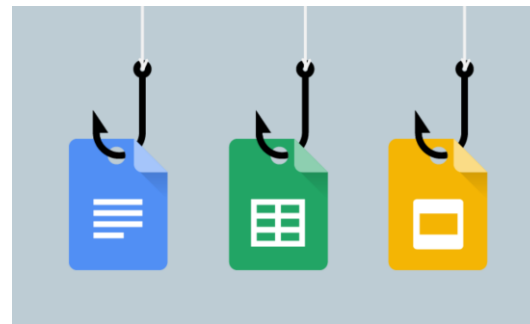


- It can cost you time

- Place Fraud Alerts on you credit reports TransUnion, Equifax and Experian.
- Contact the Fraud departments of companies you have open accounts.
- File a police report.
- File a report with the Federal Trade Commission.
